***HAVEN* continues the *HELIX* time-travel saga with a tale of love and loss**

Lives are forever changed when a programming error throws a space mission into disarray



Surrey, BC, January 26, 2024—In *HAVEN*, book two of the *HELIX* trilogy by Canadian author Graeme Bennett, a compelling story of loss and recovery is woven from several interconnected threads, beginning with the backstory of Isaac, the big bad boss character of the first book. We learn of the events leading to his spectacular fall from grace, and how it affects him and those around him.

The story then follows his son, Andrew, as he sets out with his friend George on a radical path that leads to the disappearance of the world's most valuable intellectual property: a top-secret device capable of communicating with the future.

At the heart of the story are Marjorie and Kaedra, the women Andrew loves. The beautiful and brilliant Marjorie and Andrew are poised to embark on a secretive space mission, but a programming error throws the mission into disarray and Marjorie is reported dead.

Mysteries deepen as messages warning of something called the “Omega Event” arrive from a mysterious prophet and the final message from a time traveler ominously warns others not to follow. Does it signal a terrible disaster or the beginning of a new world order?

Key themes

Key themes include storytelling as a noble tradition and the evolving relationship between two friends who drift apart. Suitable for ages 13 and up, with some non-explicit suggestive language and occasional coarse language. Topics discussed include mathematics, cryptography, genetic engineering, communications technologies, AI, cults, religions and belief systems, virtualization, climate change, mental health and dealing with grief, death and loss.
