

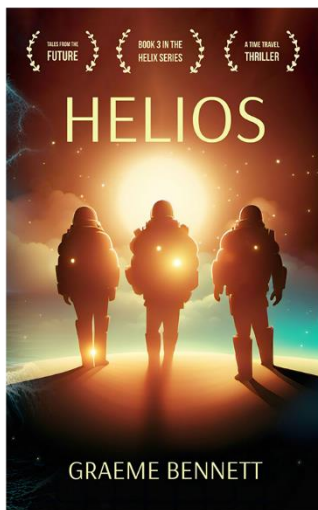

***Helios* expands the timeline and scope of the *Helix* time-travel trilogy**

Book three brings centuries-spanning story to an exciting conclusion in the sea, sky, and space



Surrey, BC, July 10, 2024—In *Helios*, book three of the Helix trilogy by Canadian author Graeme Bennett, the story begins with a secret military experiment that results in a dramatic twist to the story established in books one and two. Suddenly, particles entangled back in 1947 become available to researchers studying quantum communications in the 25th century; communication with the scientists of 1947 leads to plot developments that are, by turn, historically famous and entirely unexpected.

You'll learn the real reasons how and why the cold war started and visit the outskirts of Corona in New Mexico on a fateful night in July of 1947. The story also leads us to the world's smallest nation-state, where a secret project is underway, and to the Temple of the Sun in China, where an investigator learns of a deadly game played by factory workers in MegaFactory City. And the sun itself plays a huge role in this story, as an unprecedented solar storm threatens to wreak havoc and thwart plans. It all leads to an exciting showdown in a sacred place known as The Luminous City.

Key themes

Key themes include relationships between a young Chinese girl and her cousin, and between a husband and wife. Suitable for ages 13 and up, with some non-explicit discussion of self-harm and occasional coarse language. Other topics discussed include programming, UFOs, communications technologies, cults, solar cycles, media and politics.
