HELIOS, the third novel in the time-travel adventure series by Canadian sci-fi author Graeme Bennett, takes place in a time of great change in the human species, as hybridized intelligence augmentation technologies result in rapid advances in genetic manipulation techniques, leading to a nearly continuous state of artificially accelerated evolution that lasts until the period of disruption caused by the unprecedented solar storms of 2435–36.

HELIOS is the story of what happens when someone steals the world's most valuable intellectual property: a top-secret device capable of communicating with the future.



It all begins when a secret experiment in 1947 leads to contact with scientists and military strategists from the 25th century and a string of events in the U.S., China, Russia, and the Middle East that could lead to WW3.

Armed with the knowledge of when and where a deadly terrorist attack will occur, the time travelers attempt to thwart the attack before it leads to all-out war. It's a thrilling third entry in this series of time-travel adventures that also stands on its own as a complete standalone story.
