

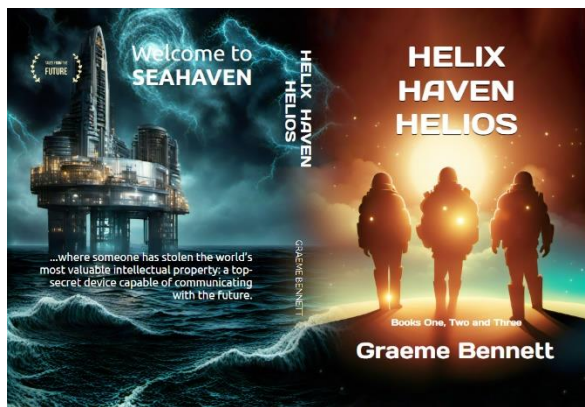

***Helix Haven Helios* takes readers time-travelling into a divided future**

Satirical sci-fi depicts a future where DNA ransomware is a thing and “intelligence augmentation” is a job requirement with a nasty downside.



Surrey, BC — With ***Helix Haven Helios***, Canadian author Graeme Bennett gathers his acclaimed trilogy of time-travel thrillers into one value-priced edition. The stories draw from his own experience as a former Microsoft employee and a globe-trotting journalist, delivering a smart and satirical sci-fi tale that takes aim at greedy corporatism and ruthless ambition with this action-packed collection that is equal parts high-tech, social satire and high-stakes drama.

In book one, the world's first time machine takes us on a wild ride into an uncertain future, as business leaders and researchers scramble to capitalize on what just might be the most impactful invention ever, powered by a generative AI algorithm that even the programmers can't fully understand.

Then, in book two, we learn the backstory of Isaac, the antagonist in the first book. We learn of the events leading to his spectacular fall from grace, and how this affects him and those around him. The story then follows his son, Andrew, as he sets out on a radical path that leads to the disappearance of the world's most valuable intellectual property: a top-secret device capable of communicating with the future.

The mysteries deepen as messages warning of something called the “Omega Event” arrive from a mysterious prophet and a final message from a time traveler ominously warns others not to follow. Does it signal a terrible disaster or the beginning of a new world order? You'll have to read book three to find out!
